In response to continuous complaints regarding the mistreatment, abuse and neglect of beach horses. Tamil Nadu Animal Welfare Board (TNAWB) is taking action to address the issue. TNAWB is pleased to announce its upcoming Horse Checkup Camp, which includes health assessments, microchipping, and licensing, scheduled to take place on August 7th, 2023, Monday, at 10:30 AM near Chepauk Stadium on MLA Hostel Road.

This initiative is to prioritize the well-being of horses through a robust licensing and microchipping system. Additionally, TNAWB seeks to collaborate with local non-governmental organizations (NGOs) to extend support for rehabilitating sick and injured horses. Most of the NGOs are over whelmed as the number of abused horses being surrendered due to last stages is high .By establishing this comprehensive registration and microchipping mechanism, we aim to create a transparent monitoring system to ensure the horses' welfare.

In a significant step towards strengthening the initiative, Directorate of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services ,Tamil Nadu Police,Tamil Nadu Veterinary, Animal Sciences University (TANUVAS) and Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) have been roped in as stakeholders. Their expertise and involvement will play a crucial role in ensuring the success of the Horse Checkup Camp and its long-term impact on animal welfare.
